Red:

The blood of Jesus(atonement), life, courage, sacrifice, holy consuming fire, love, war, cleansing: Matthew 1:21; Acts 2: 3; John 3:16; Isaiah 1:18

Orange /Orange and Red:

Praise, the fire of God, fiery trials; Holy Spirit; spiritual warfare and intercession: Isaiah 42:13; Daniel 7:9; 1 Peter 4:12-13; Hebrew 1:7; Deuteronomy 4:24; Hebrews 12:29

Yellow /Gold:

Joy, joyfulness, light, His Deity, Shekinah glory, mercy, honor, anointing oil, faith: Psalm 18:28; Esther 8:16; Zechariah 4:11-14; Proverbs 25:11-12; Colossians 3:4; Ephesians 2:7; Revelation 21:18-23; Revelation 3:18

Green:

Growth, new life -new beginnings, restoration, flourishing-prosperity, healing, healing of the nations: Psalm 23:2; Isaiah, 43:18-20; Psalm 92:13-14; 1 John 5:12; Revelation 22:2

Blue:

Holy Spirit, Divine, Living Water, authority, God's sovereignty, supreme in power, priesthood, courage: Psalm 50:1 & 66:7 & 93:1; Ephesians 1:18-21; Ephesians 5:26; John 7:38-39; Esther 8:15

Indigo:

God's sovereignty, power, authority, royalty, courage, overcomer; sovereign: 1 Corinthians 15:25; 1 John 4:4; Ephesians 1:18-21; Revelation 11:17

Purple/Violet:

Kingship, royalty, reigning with Christ, power, majesty, sovereignty, dominion; judge: John 19:2; Revelation 19:11; 1 Timothy 2:5; Revelation 1:6; Romans 8:17; John 19:2-3;

White:

Purity, holiness, innocence, righteousness, bride of Christ, purity, resurrection, heavenly garments: Matthew 17:2; Matthew 28:3; Revelation 19:8; Daniel 12:10; Isaiah 1:18

Colors: Sound and Frequency

Sound and light share the fundamental nature of vibration. And, even though the sounds we can hear have a much lower frequency than light that is visible to us, there is a range of sound frequencies that have corresponding consonant colors.

Vibrations of sound and light are very different. Sound is based on vibrations of air molecules as a moving compression wave. Light (and hence color) is based on an electromagnetic wave. While "frequency" is a measure commonly used for both compression and electromagnetic waves, the two types of waves have substantial differences.
